



NOTICE EEFE/001/2023 (ABSTRACT)

The Dean of the School of Physical Education and Sport of the University of São Paulo announces the opening faculty position (position 1236725, full-time position service), speciality "Sport Management." Interested applicants should hold a Ph.D. The position requires a commitment to teaching and the ability to conduct independent research. Applications will be accepted from March 2nd, at 0:01 a.m., to March 31st, at 23:59 p.m. (GMT-3). The entry-level monthly salary (MS3 level) is R\$ 13.357,25 plus benefits.

The public competition will cover the following program:

- 1. Concepts, historical evolution and trends of Sport Management;
- 2. Sport Management in Brazil: development and perspectives;
- 3. Organizational structure of sport in Brazil deferal legislation and systems;
- 4. Sport policy management in Brazil;
- 5. Fundamentals of the management process of sports organizations;
- 6. Management of projects and Sporting events;
- 7. Fundamentals of sports marketing;
- 8. Sport Manager: profile, skills, abilities and professional preparation;
- 9. The Sport Manager: entrepreneurship perspectives;
- 10. Governance and social responsability in the management of sports organization;
- 11. Planning tools applied to the management of sports organizations;
- 12. Research in Sport Management: methods and trends;
- 13. Sport Management: diversity and cultural identity.

The public competition will be governed by Brazilian constitutional principles, notably that of Impersonality, as well as by the Statute and the General Regulations of the University of São Paulo and the Regulations of the School of Physical Education and Sport.

Applications must be submitted exclusively via the website https://uspdigital.usp.br/gr/admissao in the period indicated above. The candidate must submit an application letter to the School of Physical Education and Sport Director. At the time of application, the candidate must present proof that he or she holds a doctor's degree granted by the USP, recognized by it or valid nationally (Art. 133, item II of USP's General Regulations). If the candidate have done his/her PhD abroad, prior to registration for the competition and with enough time to process the procedure, he/she must: either request the "equivalence of the doctor's title"(valid exclusively within the scope of USP, for competitions within the USP) or the "revalidation of the doctor's degree" (that gives the national validity of the title).
