



NOTICE EEFE/002/2023 (ABSTRACT)

The Dean of the School of Physical Education and Sport of the University of São Paulo announces the opening faculty position (position 1236717, full-time position service), speciality "School Physical Education." Interested applicants should hold a Ph.D. The position requires a commitment to teaching and the ability to conduct independent research. Applications will be accepted from March 2nd, at 0:01 a.m., to March 31st, at 23:59 p.m. (GMT-3). The entry-level monthly salary (MS3 level) is R\$ 13.357,25 plus benefits.

The public competition will cover the following program:

1. Physical Education in early childhood education;
2. Physical Education in elementary school from 1st to 5th grade;
3. Physical Education in elementary school from 6th to 9th grade;
4. Child sedentary lifestyle and school physical education;
5. Motor illiteracy and school physical education;
6. Assessment in school physical education;
7. Teaching methods in school physical education;
8. Teaching contents in school physical education;
9. Professional preparation in school physical education;
10. Production of knowledge in school physical education;
11. Autonomy in learning in school physical education.

The public contest will be governed by Brazilian constitutional principles, notably that of Impersonality, as well as by the Statute and the General Regulations of the University of São Paulo and the Regulations of the School of Physical Education and Sport.

Applications must be submitted exclusively via the website <https://uspdigital.usp.br/gr/admissao> in the period indicated above. The candidate must submit an application letter to the School of Physical Education and Sport Director. At the time of application, the candidate must present proof that he or she holds a doctor's degree granted by the USP, recognized by it or valid nationally (Art. 133, item II of USP's General Regulations). If the candidate have done his/her PhD abroad, prior to registration for the contest and with enough time to process the procedure, he/she must: either request the "equivalence of the doctor's title" (valid exclusively within the scope of USP, for competitions within the USP) or the "revalidation of the doctor's degree" (that gives the national validity of the title).
