The Director of the School of Physical Education and Sport of the University of São Paulo announces the opening faculty position (position 1241648, full-time position service), specialty "Human Body Movement Pedagogy : Physical Education in the different phases of the life cycle". Interested applicants should hold a Ph.D. The position requires a commitment to teaching and the ability to conduct independent research. Applications will be accepted from May 6th, at 0:01 a.m., to June 19th, at 23:59 p.m. (GMT-3). The entry-level monthly salary (MS3 level) is R\$ 14,761.02 plus benefits.

The public competition will cover the following program:

1. Physical Education Program in Childhood.
2. Physical Education Program in Adolescence.
3. Physical Education Program in Adulthood.
4. Physical Education Program for Seniors.
5. Physical education and the digital world : research.
6. Physical education and the digital world : professional intervention.
7. Physical education and the digital world : professional preparation.
8. Physical education and the digital world : post graduation.
9. Physical education and sedentary lifestyle.
10. Physical education and aging.

The public competition will be governed by Brazilian constitutional principles, notably that of Impersonality, as well as by the Statute and the General Regulations of the University of São Paulo and the Regulations of the School of Physical Education and Sport.

At the time of application, the candidate must present proof that he or she holds a doctorate degree granted by USP, recognized by it, or nationally valid (Art. 133, item II of USP's General Regulations). If the candidate has obtained his/her PhD abroad prior to registering for the contest and with sufficient time to complete the procedure, he or she must either request the 'equivalence of the doctorate title' (valid exclusively within the scope of USP, for competitions within USP) or the 'revalidation of the doctorate degree' (which grants national validity to the title).

Applications must be submitted exclusively via the website <https://uspdigital.usp.br/gr/admissao> in the period indicated above. Applicants must use Portuguese in their written materials and oral presentations. The candidate must submit an application letter to the School of Physical Education and Sport Director.
