The Director of the School of Physical Education and Sport of the University of São Paulo announces the opening faculty position (position 1241656, full-time position service), specialty "Paralympic Sports". Interested applicants should hold a Ph.D. The position requires a commitment to teaching and the ability to conduct independent research. Applications will be accepted from May 6th, at 0:01 a.m., to June 19th, at 23:59 p.m. (GMT-3). The entry-level monthly salary (MS3 level) is R\$ 14,761.02 plus benefits.

The public competition will cover the following program:

- 1. Classification in paralympic sport: conceptual bases and implications for training and competition.
- 2. History and development of paralympic sports.
- 3. Determining physiological factors of performance in paralympic sports.
- 4. Performance analysis in paralympic team sports.
- 5. Evaluation and training prescription for endurance paralympic athletes.
- 6. Training planning and monitoring in paralympic sports.
- 7. Evaluation and prescription of strength and power training in paralympic athletes.
- 8. Scientific knowledge in paralympic sports: state of the art and future perspectives.
- 9. Determining psychophysiological factors of performance in paralympic sports.
- 10. Evaluation of anaerobic power and capacity of paralympic athletes.
- 11. Training methods applied to paralympic sports.
- 12. Pedagogy of paralympic sports.
- 13. Socio-behavioral aspects in paralympic sports.

The public competition will be governed by Brazilian constitutional principles, notably that of Impersonality, as well as by the Statute and the General Regulations of the University of São Paulo and the Regulations of the School of Physical Education and Sport.

At the time of application, the candidate must present proof that he or she holds a doctorate degree granted by USP, recognized by it, or nationally valid (Art. 133, item II of USP's General Regulations). If the candidate has obtained his/her PhD abroad prior to registering for the contest and with sufficient time to complete the procedure, he or she must either request the 'equivalence of the doctorate title' (valid exclusively within the scope of USP, for competitions within USP) or the 'revalidation of the doctorate degree' (which grants national validity to the title).

Applications must be submitted exclusively via the website https://uspdigital.usp.br/gr/admissao in the period indicated above. Applicants must use Portuguese in their written materials and oral presentations. The candidate must submit an application letter to the School of Physical Education and Sport Director.
